

Steps to achieve the Colorado GRI designation

To obtain the Colorado GRI designation, you must take the following steps:

- Be a Colorado REALTOR® in good standing
- Complete Coursework The GRI program consists of 15 courses, each providing 4 hours of credit, for a total of 60 hours of education. Courses may be taken online, in the classroom from a sponsoring REALTOR® association, or a combination of online and classroom. All 60 hours of education toward the GRI designation must be completed within 3 years.
- **Apply for the GRI** Once the coursework is complete, an application is required through any of the sponsoring REALTOR® associations. Application fees may vary by board.

The GRI is no longer offered through the Colorado Association of REALTORS®.

Please contact one of the three local associations below if you are interested in earning the GRI designation in a classroom setting. You can also take the classes through VanEd utilizing their online platform.

Once you have completed all the required classes you will contact one of the three associations below informing them you have completed all the coursework and would like to complete an application. Once you complete the application and submit proof of classes to the local association your information will be sent to the National Associations of REALTORS® to update your records and you will receive a certificate of completion for the designation.
