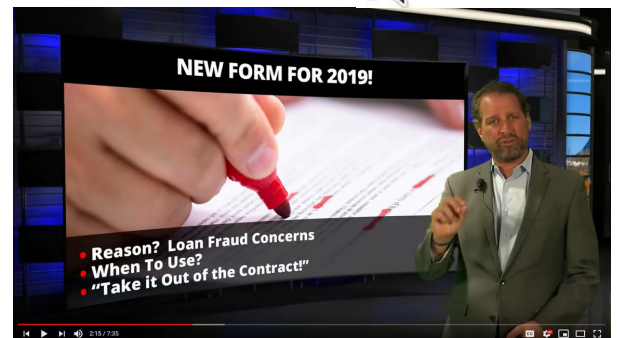
ADVOCACY WORK GROUP UPDATE
