1. Participation in Local, State and/or National Association activities, meetings, conventions, and committees.
2. Demonstrated REALTOR® enthusiasm by encouraging good real estate practices among peer and general public.
3. Demonstrated professionalism by public recognition of business conduct and service to clients.
4. Participates in service to the community, clubs, organizations, etc.

Award Criteria

1. Achievements and Contributions
 - a. REALTOR® Enthusiasm/Professionalism- Faithfulness to principles of organized real estate, laws and regulations of this Association and NAR Code of Ethics; efforts to encourage good real estate practice among other real estate brokers; time spent with press and general public explaining the real estate profession. Public recognition of business conduct, service to clients & customers, imaginative & creative advertising programs, enhancing the REALTOR® image within the community etc. (30 points)
 - b. Activity in Civic Affairs - Local, state, and national participation in civic and service clubs, charitable activities, political action, fraternal or religious groups.

(10 points)

a. Previous year

c. Activity in Local, State and/or National Associations - Association committee work, membership and offices held in local chapters of Institutes, Councils, attendance of REALTOR® Day on the Hill, VAR, NAR attendance, etc.
(25 points)

a. Previous year

d. Must be Honor Society Member for minimum of 2 years.
(10 points plus 2 points every additional year as Honor Society Member)
