### The buyer representation agreement

With this document, you'll agree to certain terms that'll determine the nature of your and your agent's relationship. Simply put, this is where you *make a deal about how they will represent you*.

### The purchase contract

Here you'll have **all the conditions of your purchase** stated. It includes the price, the date of ownership, and details about securing mortgage financing.

### Seller's property disclosure

This is one of the most neglected documents for first time homebuyers in Texas that's actually quite important. It's necessary since it'll help you *find out about any flaws* that could decrease your future home's value.

## Home inspection and appraisal report

Although similar, these two things aren't really the same. While the home appraisal is mandatory, the home inspection isn't. The home inspection only takes the condition of the home into consideration when writing their report, while **the home appraisal is much more thorough**.

## Owner's title insurance policy

Although you're not required to have this policy, it's a good idea to get it. Even though it's not the most necessary of all these important documents for first time homebuyers in Texas, it still holds a lot of value. Having it will *make sure that you're safe* in case the previous homeowner wants to sue you stating that they have a claim over your home. Many lenders demand this document since it's their money that's at stake.

## Homeowners insurance policy

This document **protects your belongings**, be it your home or anything in it. Having it is highly recommended since you never really know what could happen to your property while you're absent.

## Closing disclosure

Here you'll have all the **information about the mortgage loan** you've chosen and everything that goes with it. Once your closing disclosure is to your liking, you can close the deal.

## Property deed

This is the final important document for first time homebuyers in Texas. Once you've signed this one, it means that *the property no longer belongs to the previous owner* but is now yours.
