Dear Student:

Thank you for wanting to take our Ohio concealed carry training through L.E.O. Ohio Concealed Carry. Exercising your 2nd Amendment rights has never been more important and imperative to protecting yourself and your family.

Your training on Saturday June 27, 2020 will start at 8am at the Chamber Garden Room at the former Harding Hotel at 222 W. Center Street, Marion Ohio. Every hour of classroom instruction will usually last for 50 minutes with a 10 minute break. There will be enough time to smoke if you choose to do so. The class will run from 8am and ends at 4pm. The range portion of the course will take place in Waldo, which we will discuss in class. COVID-19 precautions will be observed in the classroom.

You are NOT permitted to bring any ammunition with you to class (leave it in your car). Firearms used for the course MUST be modern (no antique or black powder allowed). We recommend that you shoot the firearm that you are planning on carrying concealed but this is not mandatory. You will need to bring a minimum 100 rounds of ammunition and ammunition must be factory loaded (no reloads allowed). If you do not have a firearm to bring to class then you must purchase 100 rounds of regular round tipped .22 caliber ammunition (Federal blue box please) so that you can qualify on one of mine.

On the day of class bring a notebook and a couple of pencils to take the written test. There will be plenty of time to go over course materials, take the test and have open discussions about concealed carry and use of force. You are responsible for your own lunch so coolers and food are allowed.. There are vending machines and water fountains in the area we will be in. While you are eating lunch we will continue to teach.

Since I am a full time law enforcement officer and employed at the Marion County Sheriff's Office, our students are NOT permitted to get their Ohio Concealed Handgun License from the Marion County Sheriff's Office. This has been deemed a conflict of interest by the Ohio Ethics Commission. You must instead get your license from an adjacent county sheriff's office from where you live. Because of this we will try to provide you with hours of operation and procedures for going to another sheriff's office.

Lastly, your 2 hours of range time will be held at an outdoor location at the end of the day. Remember to dress for the weather as we will shoot regardless of the conditions. You must bring your own eye and ear protection to the range when we shoot. It might be beneficial if you have a range bag for all of your gear and bringing a camp or lawn chair would also be beneficial. There are no bathroom facilities at the range but the Duke station in Waldo is 5 min away.
