



2022 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

APPLICATIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS are available to graduating high school students from Cherokee, Clay or Graham Counties & including Nantahala High School who demonstrate academic strength, leadership, community involvement and financial need. Scholarships are for tuition and/or books, have no cash value and are non-transferable.

CRITERIA for ELEGIBILITY

Applicant must be a US Citizen, a North Carolina resident and a graduating senior with a 2.85 GPA or above.

Applicant must plan to attend a two- or four-year college, university or community college as a fulltime student beginning Fall of 2022.

This is an academic excellence and need based scholarship. Preference may be given to those with greater financial need.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES CHECKLIST

To be considered, each applicant must submit *ALL* the following:

- **Completed Application**
- **Two letters of recommendation**, One from a faculty member. One from an unrelated adult.
- **High School Transcript and SAT/ACT official report of scores**. If not available explain why.
- **Personal Essay** stating your qualifications, including personal background, leadership, educational and personal goals, special contributions, and volunteer work at school and/or the community and your career interests. (See Essay Section IV)
- **Copy of requested Tax Return** with social security numbers blacked out. *ALL sensitive documents will be handled with care and be properly shredded following recipient selection.*

This application and the essay are to be completed by the STUDENT. Any submissions deemed to be completed by another person will not be considered for the award.

To be eligible for consideration, applicants must submit a completed application and ALL supporting documents to the Scholarship Committee postmarked no later than **March 1st** and mailed to **MLBOR, 93 Tennessee Street, Murphy, NC 28906** -or- You can drop it off during normal office hours, Monday - Friday, 9:00am - 4:00pm. (No exceptions will be made to the deadline; late applications will not be considered.)

Winning Recipients will be notified by phone. Certificates will be mailed/delivered to the high school for presentation at the school's Senior Awards Ceremony.

Funds are paid directly to the school of choice.
