

Stamford Small Business COVID-19 Relief Grant

The City of Stamford established the Stamford Small Business COVID-19 Relief Grant to provide limited, one-time direct financial assistance up to \$10,000 to eligible Stamford for-profit small businesses that have been adversely impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

One-third of total grants will be reserved for small business enterprises who are owned and operated by minorities, women, people with disabilities, and veterans. Businesses who qualify for these reserved grants will need to submit a <u>self-certification form</u> as part of their application.

The application for this grant will be available on this website on Monday, April 3rd, 2023.



New Parking Garage

- o 928 spaces (38 EV chargers, capacity to add 55 more)
- o Bicycle storage with secure charging for e-bikes
- o Available space by level signage
- o Architectural façade with color changing LED lighting
- o Parksmart Certified High-Performance, Sustainable Design

o Direct connection to platform at Track 5

- Enclosed pedestrian bridge to STC upper concourse
- o Construction cost \$77.7m
- o Completion Summer 2023

Elevator and Escalator Improvements



Upgrades of critical components to five (5) elevators to allow them to interface with new technology, as well as increase performance, improve safety, and update aesthetics.

Upgrades to seventeen (17) escalators, by replacing all the mechanical equipment while reutilizing the existing truss structures, resulting in improved performance, increased efficiency, and up-to-date safety features.
